Sea Bird Watch and Woodcock Events Scheduled

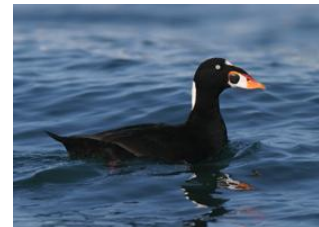
