WHAT: Floating wetlands installation to improve water quality in Ft. Pond, Montauk

WHEN: Saturday, May 20, 2023, 9 am – 1 pm (approximately)

CCOM is looking for able-bodied, motivated volunteers to take part in year two of our innovative water quality remediation project for Fort Pond in Montauk. We will need 25-30 volunteers.

ABOUT THE PROJECT:

CCOM was awarded a grant through the Long Island Community Foundation (LICF) to install (6) 500 sq. ft., seasonal floating wetlands in Ft. Pond.

Native plants (7,200 in total) will be set into floating mats; as the plants mature, their roots will uptake excess nitrogen and phosphorus as food. The goal is to reduce the nutrient load in the Pond to minimize risk of harmful algal blooms, which have plagued the Pond for years.

WHAT TO EXPECT | WHAT TO BRING:

- Assemble foam mats
- Transplant native plants into special containers to fit into mats (work gloves recommended)
- Transport plants from potting table to mats (ability to lift up to 25 lbs.)
- Fit containers into mats
- Help float mats into shallow water to prepare for final transport to moorings (boots / waders)
